As this book is not a reference manual, it might be useful for you to have a reference manual, such as [cppreference](http://en.cppreference.com/w/cpp) ([en.cppreference.com/w/cpp](http://en.cppreference.com/w/cpp)), at your side to clarify any confusing points. It will definitely help to have a C++17 compiler handy. At press time, there are several more or less feature-complete C++17 implementations, including GCC, Clang, and Microsoft Visual Studio. You can run them locally or via many free online compiler services, such as [Wandbox](http://wandbox.org) ([wandbox.org](http://wandbox.org)), [Godbolt](http://gcc.godbolt.org) ([gcc.godbolt.org](http://gcc.godbolt.org)), and [Rextester](http://rextester.com) ([rextester.com](http://rextester.com)).
